Please be advised that approval by the Town of Betterton Town Manager and the Building Inspector from Middle Department Inspection Agency is required before any construction is started. Projects that affect the exterior footprint of the house, also need approval of the Planning and Zoning Committee.

After approval of the plans and permit, periodic inspections need to be done by MDIA.

Inspections are required as follows:

- 1. Footer—Inspection is required after footer is dug and before concrete is poured.
- 2. Foundation—Inspection is required when foundation is laid.
- 3. Framing—Inspection of Electric and Plumbing is required when framing is done.
- 4. Insulation—Inspection is required when insulation is complete, before drywall is installed.
- 5. Final—Inspection is required when building is finished completely.

All inspections are requested by the property owner or the builder, electrician, or plumber. Craig from Middle Departments does the inspection.

It is your responsibility to contact Middle Departments (MDIA) at 1-800-242-6342 for the necessary inspections after Town of Betterton issues your permit.
